HEALTH AND SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT POLICY STATEMENT

The purpose of this top level Statement of Intent is to meet the scope *“The manufacture and assembly of stamped and machined components in brass, aluminium and other alloys. The manufacture of a propriety range of drain, sewer and chimney cleaning and testing equipment, associated tools and accessories. The extrusion of polypropylene and polyvinyl chloride material to customers’ specifications”.*
